

2025 CSA Member Information

Ward Vegetables grows healthy, nutrient dense, local vegetables, **year round** and **harvest** those awesome veggies approximately **40 weeks** of the year. This season is our 18th year of growing vegetables and operating the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) and our 8th year of offering vegetables almost year round.

Our **CSA** requires you to be a **member** but **does not** require you to order each week, you pick up only when you order produce. With this very customized model you are able to have the veggies you want to eat and determine when you use your CSA year round! The CSA model works like a debit card, you pay your membership fee, then order the vegetables you want, pick them up on our pickup days and we deduct the cost from your balance. You can rejoin at any time **but we encourage you to use your membership up in one calendar year!** We are only a member based CSA, no retail sales.

There are three levels of **membership** for you to choose from and a new program that you can contribute to:

- **Salad Bar Membership** - requires a membership fee of \$350 to \$500, *upon renewal you receive a free week of your average order of veggies.* We encourage you to use up your membership in one calendar year.
- **Good Veggies Membership** - requires a membership fee of \$150 to \$300, *upon renewal you receive a free week of your average order of veggies.* We encourage you to use up your membership in one calendar year.
- **Keeping It Local Membership** - requires a membership fee of \$100.
- **Donation to The Healthy Share** - your donation goes to funding several shares for local families who are in need of healthy vegetables. This program was new in 2022 and we are excited to offer our members an opportunity to contribute small amounts to help this needed venture.

Each month you receive a statement of what you have purchased and your remaining balance. When you run out of your membership you have the option of re-joining or joining again at a different time. If you rejoin, any balance you have remaining on your previous membership will be moved to your new balance. *If you are a current member you will notice that our memberships have changed. In order to streamline our processes and keep our costs reasonable we have taken out the discounts (2022) and products (2023). The membership levels allow you to invest your grocery dollars into nutrient rich, local, tasty food. If you are at the Salad Bar or Good Veggies you do not have to renew your memberships as often and you still receive a free bag of goodies upon your renewal.*

The following vegetables (based on temperatures and sunlight) are available throughout the year. Also, we introduce new products each year so some may not be listed on this sheet. We do our best to keep our prices affordable, please realize that average seed costs have risen 5% per year since 2020.

• Herbs - wide variety	½ oz bag	\$1.00/half oz (dried herbs will be available, (no price yet)
• Fennel Bulb	bulb	\$3.50/bulb (depending on size)
• Edible Flowers -	10-15/bag,	\$2.00, summer, fall
• Beans - variety	1 lb bag,	\$4.50/lb, summer, fall, possible dry beans winter of 2023
• Beets -	5/bunch,	\$3.50, year round (depends on inside space during winter)
• Cabbage -	1 Head,	\$5.00/cabbage, spring, fall
• Carrots -	6/bunch,	\$4.00, year round (depends on inside space during winter)
• Cucumbers -	1 indivd,	\$1.00/cucumber, summer, fall
• Eggplant -	1 indivd,	\$2.50/eggplant, summer, fall
• Garlic -	1 bulb,	\$1.00, spring, summer, fall, winter
• Bunching Onions	6/bunch,	\$3.00, spring, summer
• Yellow Onions -	1 lb/bag,	\$4.00/lb, fall, winter, spring (minimum charge is 1 lb)
• Sugar Peas -	3 oz bag,	\$3.00, spring, summer, fall (experimenting with winter growing)
• Peppers - wide variety	1 indivd,	\$0.75/pepper, summer, fall (you choose sweet or hot or both)
• Radishes -	10/bunch,	\$3.00, year round with some limited times
• Rhubarb -	1 lb/bunch,	\$3.00/lb, spring, usually around 7 stalks
• Shallots -	1 to 2,	\$1.50, fall, winter, spring
• Summer Squash -	1 indivd,	\$1.00/squash, summer, fall (patty pan, zucchini, yellow)
• Tomatoes -	/lb ,	\$3.50/lb Ward Roma - average of 3 to 4 equals a pound
• Tomatoberry -	15/bag,	\$4.00, summer, fall, Ward Tomatoberry
• Turnips -	3/bunch,	\$3.00, spring, fall, winter
• Maple Syrup -	12 oz or Qt	\$14 and \$18 respectively
• Honey -	Quart	\$20
• Elderberry Syrup	Pint	\$32, seasonal value added product
• Hot Sauce	8oz	\$10, available during summer and fall
• Salsa	Pint	\$10, available during summer and fall
• Jam and Vinegar -	Jar	\$7.00

As with any CSA, the member assumes some of the risk of growing vegetables with the farmer. You are purchasing your share prior to all crops being planted and the farmer knowing exactly what Mother Nature might have in store for us in any one season, If for some reason (mostly Mother Nature) multiple crops fail your membership can be applied to the next “season” when vegetables are growing or ***you can sell your share to someone who may be interested in joining our CSA.*** We do not offer a refund.

The ordering process happens Saturday thru Sunday with pickup taking place on Tuesday and Wednesday between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. unless other arrangements have been made with Farmer John. If you order vegetables and do not pick them up your **account** will still be **debited**.

We also partner with other farms in our area to have their products available during your pickup. If you choose, there are **grass-fed meats** (Beef, Pork, Chicken available by individual package or through a share). Raw Milk and raw milk product **herd shares** and open range **eggs** (retail or share). Sourdough Artisan bread either through a share or retail. ***None of the above products are included in the Ward Vegetables CSA share*** but are available during your pickup. We coordinate with these farms to have their products here during your regular pickup.

Thank you for your interest and please let me know if you have any questions. The CSA takes new members year round. We are 100 members strong each year and will be accepting new members starting in January of 2025.
